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One of Koreatown's most beloved restaurants is no doubt Ham Ji Park. Named after the hamjibag, a sort of large wooden platter used to serve food, the restaurant was started by one Hwa Shin Kim, a South Korean native who came to the US in 1989 at age 50. After working at restaurants in K-Town, she opened the original Arlington Heights location of Ham Ji Park in 1993. This second tital ("daughter") outpost on 6th, meanwhile, debuted in late 2002. - KevinEats

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
